They will contribute to the course “Business Associations,” which examines the laws governing the organization, internal governance, and financing of corporations and other business entities.

Christopher is a shareholder attorney and partner in BLB&G’s Corporate Governance practice, focusing on breach of fiduciary duty litigation against boards and executives. He has played a leading role in recovering hundreds of millions of dollars for investors, enhancing corporate governance practices, and upholding shareholder rights in high-profile cases, including *In re Mindbody, Inc. Stockholders Litigation* and *In re Columbia Pipeline Group, Inc.*, among others. Christopher frequently serves as a guest lecturer at Columbia Law School, Villanova University, and the University of Connecticut School of Law.
